The objective of the meeting is to promote dialogue between Latin American and U.S. lawyers who do international pro bono work. The discussion will focus on the experience of law firm signatories of the ***Pro Bono Declaration for the Americas***, and the implementation of the ***International Pro Bono Network***.

The ***International Pro Bono Network*** ([www.ipbnetwork.org](http://www.ipbnetwork.org)) is an initiative of Fundación Pro Bono Chile and the Cyrus R. Vance Center for International Justice. It is made up of local pro bono referral programs and law firms from 13 countries across the Americas. The Network coordinates the work of volunteer attorneys who engage in projects ranging from participation in the Inter-American system for the protection of human rights to support of civil society organizations. The ***Pro Bono Declaration for the Americas***, a project of the Vance Center, is the first-ever hemisphere-wide statement of a lawyer’s social responsibility, and commits lawyers to undertake a minimum of 20 hours of pro bono legal services on behalf of the poor and marginalized, and organizations that serve them. To date, over 500 law firms from across the Americas have voluntarily adhered to the Declaration.
